Accelerated Master Degree Programs Graduate College

Program Description

Accelerated master's programs enable outstanding Missouri State undergraduate students to begin graduate work while completing their undergraduate program. Students who are admitted to an accelerated master's program are allowed to apply a certain number of courses to both their undergraduate degree and their graduate degree.

Students accepted into an accelerated program must complete a "Mixed Credit" form prior to registering for courses intended to satisfy both undergraduate and graduate requirements. This form can be obtained from the student's department or the Graduate College, Carrington Hall, room 306.

Program Offerings

Listed below are the graduate programs at Missouri State offering an accelerated option. Beside each option is listed the number of credit hours which can be counted for mixed credit toward finishing the undergraduate degree and starting the graduate degree.

1. Master of Accountancy (6 credit hours)
2. Master of Business Administration (6 credit hours)
3. Master of Public Administration (12 credit hours)
4. Master of Science, Biology (12 credit hours)
5. Master of Science, Cell and Molecular Biology (6 credit hours)
6. Master of Science, Chemistry (12 credit hours)
7. Master of Science, Geospatial Sciences in Geography and Geology (12 credit hours)
8. Master of Science, Material Science (9 credit hours)
9. Master of Science, Mathematics (6 credit hours)
10. Master of Natural and Applied Science (12 credit hours)
11. Master of Science, Nursing (10 hours)
12. Master of Arts, Religious Studies (12 credit hours)

Eligibility and Requirements

Students must apply and be admitted to the accelerated master's program by the department and the Graduate College. Each department is responsible for determining eligibility and requirements for their accelerated program.
