## Graduate Assistantship (half) - Trombone

Starting Date: August 2024

- Duties:** May include: teaching applied lessons, coaching chamber ensembles, assisting with Trombone Choir, Studio Class and group warmups, or other duties as needed.
- Compensation:** Complete tuition waiver (in or out-of- state) of up to 6 credit hours per semester (plus 3 credits in the summer) and a stipend of \$5,980 per year for two years.
- Qualifications:** Completion of an undergraduate degree in music, experience in trombone instruction, excellent performance skills, a minimum GPA of 3.0 and acceptance into the Missouri State University Graduate College. Preference will be given to students pursuing the Master of Music degree.
- Degrees Offered:** The Department of Music offers Master of Music degrees in Performance, Pedagogy, Conducting, Music Education, and Composition.
