We have two positions available at the start of the summer semester. Candidates must be able to commit to a minimum of one year due to the training and responsibilities inherent in this role. Successful Graduate Assistants may be offered a second year assistantship.

<u>Requirements:</u> Applicants <u>must</u> be enrolled in a Master's or Doctorate program in Clinical Psychology, Counseling, or Social Work. Preference will be given to students who have completed at least one full semester in their respective program.
