Judging Criteria

Oral Presentation

Presentation Style:

- Presenter spoke clearly with sufficient volume.
- Focus of the talk was made clear early in presentation, and it was reinforced during presentation.
- Presentation flowed in a logical sequence.
- Presenter evidenced a clear knowledge of the material and, if used, visual or auditory aids were effective.

Quality of Research/Creative Work:

- Research problem or creative work had potential for answering questions or appeals to a broader audience.
- Methods utilized were appropriate to nature of research and the question asked.
- Evidence that student work builds upon literature and knowledge in the field of endeavor.
- Extensiveness of work done, including level of effort, level of difficulty, and appropriate use of visual aids.
- Indication that the outcome of the work could be of value to others in the discipline, or beyond the field.
- Written abstract is a good summary that includes outcomes/summary of the work.

Poster Presentation

Poster Style:

- The poster (including title/author) is clearly readable, with large text and figures; good use of color
- The poster flows in logical sequence and would be understandable without student present.
- Written abstract is a good summary that includes outcomes/summary of the work.
- Extensiveness of work done including level of effort, degree of difficulty, and preparation of the poster.
- Indication that the outcome of the work could be of value to others in the discipline or beyond the field.
