The Kinesiology Graduate Program (MS) at Missouri State University (Springfield campus), with tracks in Sports/Human Performance and Sport Pedagogy, is currently accepting applications for **graduate teaching assistantships** starting in the spring 2027 semester. Assistantships are renewable for a maximum of two (2) years. Housed in the School of Health Sciences ([School of Health Sciences - Missouri State](#)), the Kinesiology Graduate Program prepares students for careers in strength and conditioning, exercise physiology in clinical and fitness settings, coaching, education, sports administration, as well as research and academia. The program's curriculum emphasizes application and theory in strength and conditioning, exercise physiology, biomechanics, exercise and sport psychology, sports administration, statistics, and research methods. Requirements to Apply:

- A bachelor's degree in a related field such as exercise science/physiology, kinesiology, recreation, biology, or sports medicine is required. Applicants with degrees outside of these fields will not be considered.

General Description and Responsibilities of the Position:

- Work 20 hours per week each semester
- Maintain regular, weekly office hours
- Teach lecture and laboratory courses as assigned
- Create, prepare, and update course materials
- Utilize the university's LMS (Brightspace D2L) for course communication, organization, and grading
- Assist with set up/take-down of classroom spaces and equipment as needed
- Sanitation and organization of laboratory equipment and spaces as needed
- Assist faculty with research projects and data collection as assigned
- Other duties as assigned
